

Spelling list: Irregular Verbs: Past Simple Form (p, q, and r words)

Irregular verbs in English, beginning with the letters p, q, and r. Learn the verbs in their past simple form in column one. See the verbs used in context in column two.

paid	We paid for yesterday's shopping in cash. (pay - paid - paid)
put	I put my uniform away after school yesterday. (put - put - put)
quit	Last week, I quit my job. (quit - quit - quit)
read	Last week, we read 'Hamlet' in English. (read - read - read)
rode	Yesterday, I rode my bike to school. (ride - rode - ridden)
rang	I rang my friend last week. (ring - rang - rung)
rose	The sun rose at 5am yesterday morning. (rise - rose - risen)
ran	I ran a race last year. (run - ran - run)
