

## Spelling list: Irregular Verbs: Past Simple Form (p, q, and r words)

Irregular verbs in English, beginning with the letters p, q, and r. Learn the verbs in their past simple form in column one. See the verbs used in context in column two.

paid	We <b>paid</b> for yesterday's shopping in cash. (pay - <b>paid</b> - paid)
put	I <b>put</b> my uniform away after school yesterday. (put - <b>put</b> - put)
quit	Last week, I <b>quit</b> my job. (quit - <b>quit</b> - quit)
read	Last week, we <b>read</b> 'Hamlet' in English. (read - <b>read</b> - read)
rode	Yesterday, I <b>rode</b> my bike to school. (ride - <b>rode</b> - ridden)
rang	I <b>rang</b> my friend last week. (ring - <b>rang</b> - rung)
rose	The sun <b>rose</b> at 5am yesterday morning. (rise - <b>rose</b> - risen)
ran	I <b>ran</b> a race last year. (run - <b>ran</b> - run)
