

Spelling list: Irregular Verbs: Past Participle Form (t and u words)

Irregular verbs in English, beginning with the letters t and u. Learn the verbs in their past participle form in column one. See the verbs used in context in column two.

taken	I have already taken some time off work this month. (take - took - taken)
taught	The Maths teacher has just taught them fractions. (teach - taught - taught)
torn	He has just torn his trousers. (tear - tore - torn)
told	The teacher has just told the class a story. (tell - told - told)
thought	We have already thought about going on holiday. (think - thought - thought)
thrown	She has thrown the javelin every summer so far. (throw - threw - thrown)
trodden	She has just trodden on her sister's foot! (tread - trod - trodden)
understood	I have understood every lesson so far. (understand - understood - understood)
