eerie	Eerie (adjective) – strange and frightening.
sinister	(adjective) – giving the impression that something harmful or evil is happening or will happen.
secluded	Secluded (adjective) - place – sheltered and private // person – having little contact with other people.
subterranean	Subterranean (adjective) – existing, occurring under the earth's surface.
foreboding	Foreboding (noun) – a feeling that something bad is going to happen.
ominous	Ominous (adjective) – suggesting that something bad is going to happen.
dingy	Dingy (adjective) gloomy and drab.
isolated	Isolated (adjective) remote and lonely.
mysterious	Mysterious (adjective) difficult or impossible to understand or explain.
