Both the /u:/ and /ju:/ (oo and yoo) sounds can be spelt as u e, ue and ew. If words end in the /oo/ sound, ue and ew are more common spellings than oo.

down Crossword clues go across and **down** .

town It was a misty day so the **town** was in gloom.

fowl Hens and ducks are domestic **fowl** .

growl A dog might **growl** to protect its pups.
