

Spelling list: Non-statutory words: ew (copy)

Both the /u:/ and /ju:/ (oo and yoo) sounds can be spelt as u e, ue and ew. If words end in the /oo/ sound, ue and ew are more common spellings than oo.

brew	The lady allowed the tea to brew .
threw	She threw the ball through my window.
screw	Screw the lid back on the bottle.
