

## Spelling list: ay and oy spellings

Some useful spelling guidelines, Letters and Sounds, Phase Six. The ai and oi spellings do not occur at the end of English words or immediately before suffixes; instead, the ay and oy spellings are used in these positions.

play	Can we <b>play</b> golf tonight?
played	He <b>played</b> a bugle in the brass band.
playing	You can earn a living by <b>playing</b> music.
playful	The kitten was <b>playful</b> .
joy	The baby has brought them great <b>joy</b> .
joyful	It was a <b>joyful</b> day.
enjoying	Joe was <b>enjoying</b> himself at the party.
enjoyment	People get <b>enjoyment</b> out of watching football.
