digestion A process called **digestion** turns food into a form that your body can use.

gullet The **gullet** is a tube that goes from the mouth to the stomach.

ingestion **Ingestion** is putting food into your mouth.

onto sugar.

stomach In the **stomach** the food is churned up with strong acid.

rectum Faeces are stored in the **rectum**.

molecules The particles that make up food are called **molecules** .

intestine The digestive system has both large and small **intestine** .

gut All the organs of the digestive system apart from the mouth.

enzymes **Enzymes** are able to digest food that has been eaten.

Muscles in the wall of the gullet contract(get smaller) to narrow the tube

above the food.

appendix The **appendix** is a small tube branching off the large intestine.
