continuous	My computer makes a continuous low buzzing noise.
deciduous	Oak trees are deciduous .
impetuous	He would come to regret his impetuous decision.
incongruous	Her designer handbag looked incongruous with her gym clothes and trainers.
innocuous	Her question was innocuous .
sensuous	Her singing voice was deep and sensuous .
sumptuous	We shared a sumptuous feast.
superfluous	I need to cut the superfluous words from my essay.
tempestuous	The ship sailed the tempestuous sea.
tenuous	The link between the arguments was tenuous but worth interrogating.
tortuous	The wait would be tortuous .
tumultuous	A tumultuous sound was heard from above.
virtuous	The vicar was virtuous .
