

Spelling list: Irregular Verbs: Past Participle Form (f words)

Irregular verbs in English, beginning with the letter f. Learn the verbs in their past participle form in column one. See the verbs used in context in column two.

fallen	I have just fallen over. (fall - fell - fallen)
fed	Have you fed the dogs yet? (feed - fed - fed)
felt	I have never felt as tired as I did after yesterday's walk. (feel - felt - felt)
fought	The children have never fought over their toys. (fight - fought - fought)
found	I have found all the spelling tests this year very easy. (find - found - found)
fled	Even though the rain isn't heavy, we have already fled the beach. (flee - fled - fled)
flown	The pilot has just flown from England to America. (fly - flew - flown)
forgotten	I have never forgotten to practise my spellings. (forget - forgot - forgotten)
forgiven	He has already forgiven his friend for lying to him. (forgive - forgave - forgiven)
frozen	The roads have not frozen yet. (freeze - froze - frozen)
