flown The pilot has just **flown** from England to America. (fly - flew - **flown**)

forgotten I have never **forgotten** to practise my spellings. (forget - forgot - **forgotten**)

He has already **forgiven** his friend for lying to him. (forgive - forgave - forgiven

forgiven)

frozen The roads have not **frozen** yet. (freeze - froze - **frozen**)
