

Spelling list: Irregular Verbs: Past Simple Form (f words)

Irregular verbs in English, beginning with the letter f. Learn the verbs in their past simple form in column one. See the verbs used in context in column two.

fell	I fell over last week. (fall - fell - fallen)
fed	I fed the dogs last night. (feed - fed - fed)
felt	I felt tired after yesterday's long walk. (feel - felt - felt)
fought	Last Christmas, the children fought over their toys. (fight - fought - fought)
found	I found last week's spelling test very easy. (find - found - found)
fled	Last summer, we fled the beach when it started to rain. (flee - fled - fled)
flew	Last year, the pilot flew from England to America. (fly - flew - flown)
forgot	I forgot to practise my spellings last week. (forget - forgot - forgotten)
forgave	Yesterday, he forgave his friend for lying to him. (forgive - forgave - forgiven)
froze	The roads froze when it snowed last week. (freeze - froze - frozen)
