

## Spelling list: Irregular Verbs: Past Simple Form (f words)

Irregular verbs in English, beginning with the letter f. Learn the verbs in their past simple form in column one. See the verbs used in context in column two.

fell	I <b>fell</b> over last week. (fall - <b>fell</b> - fallen)
fed	I <b>fed</b> the dogs last night. (feed - <b>fed</b> - fed)
felt	I <b>felt</b> tired after yesterday's long walk. (feel - <b>felt</b> - felt)
fought	Last Christmas, the children <b>fought</b> over their toys. (fight - <b>fought</b> - fought)
found	I <b>found</b> last week's spelling test very easy. (find - <b>found</b> - found)
fled	Last summer, we <b>fled</b> the beach when it started to rain. (flee - <b>fled</b> - fled)
flew	Last year, the pilot <b>flew</b> from England to America. (fly - <b>flew</b> - flown)
forgot	I <b>forgot</b> to practise my spellings last week. (forget - <b>forgot</b> - forgotten)
forgave	Yesterday, he <b>forgave</b> his friend for lying to him. (forgive - <b>forgave</b> - forgiven)
froze	The roads <b>froze</b> when it snowed last week. (freeze - <b>froze</b> - frozen)
