

Spelling list: After *l* and *r* use *sion*

After the letters *l* and *r* the sound sh`n is usually spelled *sion* .

convulsion	The patient experienced a major convulsion on the way to hospital.
emulsion	The room was painted in white emulsion paint.
expulsion	He was threatened with expulsion .
propulsion	The birds used their wings for propulsion .
version	I think the original version of this film was much better.
conversion	Do you know where to get the best conversion rates?
diversion	He pretended to feel unwell as a diversion while she sneaked into the classroom.
perversion	She was accused of perversion of the course of justice.
subversion	The actor's portrayal of the villain was a subversion of traditional archetypes.
excursion	The class went out on an excursion .
