

Spelling list: Words with doubled letters (copy)

These words are examples of the doubling rule: when a word ends in a short vowel and one consonant we must double the consonant when adding a vowel suffix.

flapping	The bird was flapping its wings.
getting	My spelling is getting much better.
runner	The runner showed great endurance.
spotted	We spotted a kingfisher on the river bank.
biggish	The promotion will be a biggish step up for her.
jogger	The jogger runs five miles a day.
funny	Bob's wedding speech was very funny .
snobbish	I don't like snobbish people.
snappy	He was very snappy when he was hungry.
setting	The house is in a tranquil riverside setting .
hidden	I have hidden my sweets from my brother.
trodden	I think you have trodden in something smelly.
dipped	I dipped my foot in the freezing water.
