

## Spelling list: Notation

These words are all related to the notation of music.

treble	The notes the sopranos sing are found on the <b>treble</b> clef in the music.
clef	The notes the sopranos sing are found on the treble <b>clef</b> in the music.
time	We have to keep <b>time</b> in a piece of music.
signature	The time <b>signature</b> of a piece of music tells us how many beats there are in a bar.
bar	In notation, each <b>bar</b> of the music contains the same number of beats.
line	A bar <b>line</b> is used to divide the music up into sections, each containing the same number of beats.
double	A <b>double</b> bar line is used to show when the piece of music is finished.
crotchet	A <b>crotchet</b> note lasts for one beat.
minim	A <b>minim</b> note lasts for two beats.
quaver	A <b>quaver</b> note lasts for half a beat; that's why they usually come in pairs.
rest	A <b>rest</b> in music notation shows you where you don't play.
repeat	A <b>repeat</b> sign shows you when you have to play a passage twice.
