

## Spelling list: The plural of words ending in CONSONANT y is -ies

The plural of words ending in CONSONANT + y = 'ies'. The plural of words ending in VOWEL + y = 's'.

lady	The <b>lady</b> wore a red hat.
ladies	The <b>ladies</b> were wearing funny hats.
boy	The <b>boy</b> ate some cake.
boys	Alan is a boy's name.
baby	The <b>baby</b> gave a loud wail.
babies	<b>Babies</b> are dependent on their mothers for food.
puppy	Your new <b>puppy</b> is adorable.
puppies	<b>Puppies</b> are usually excitable.
key	I have misplaced my door <b>key</b> again.
keys	Fred can never find his car <b>keys</b> .
donkey	A mule is a cross between a horse and a <b>donkey</b> .
donkeys	You sometimes see <b>donkeys</b> at the seaside.
holiday	I have some <b>holiday</b> pay due to me.
holidays	Find the best <b>holidays</b> in our new brochure.
jelly	Frog spawn looks like <b>jelly</b> .
jellies	Her favourite sweets were the fruit-flavoured <b>jellies</b> .
