artery	An <b>artery</b> is a blood vessel that carries blood from the heart to the body.
backbone	The <b>backbone</b> is the series of vertebrae forming the axis of the skeleton and protecting the spinal cord.
bone	<b>Bone</b> is rigid connective tissue that makes up the skeleton of vertebrates.
muscle	<b>Muscle</b> is tissue consisting predominantly of contractile cells.
nerve	A <b>nerve</b> is a fiber that transmits impulses of sensation from the brain to the rest of the body.
pelvis	The <b>pelvis</b> is the structure of the vertebrate skeleton supporting the lower limbs in humans.
rib	A <b>rib</b> is one of twelve pairs of curved arches of bone extending from the spine to or toward the sternum.
skeleton	A <b>skeleton</b> is the hard structure (bones and cartilages) that provides a frame for the body of an animal.
skull	The <b>skull</b> is the bony skeleton of the head of vertebrates.
spine	The <b>spine</b> is the series of vertebrae forming the axis of the skeleton and protecting the spinal cord.
vein	A <b>vein</b> is a blood vessel that carries blood from the capillaries toward the heart.
