listening	He was <b>listening</b> to his music.
listened	I <b>listened</b> to the Psalm in church.
mixing	A mixture is a <b>mixing</b> together of two or more substances without actually joining them, so that they can be separated again.
mixed	John <b>mixed</b> the ingredients into a creamy consistency.
flagging	The workmen were <b>flagging</b> the drive.
flagged	I had my drive <b>flagged</b> .
regretted	Jill <b>regretted</b> the fact that she had become rather unpunctual and resolved to do something about it.
regretting	I am <b>regretting</b> that I ever made this decision.
entertaining	The singer was very <b>entertaining</b> .
entertained	Rhymes have your mouth <b>entertained</b> .
