Nature, Plants

bark	Bark is the tough protective covering of the woody stems and roots of trees and other woody plants.
branch	A branch is a division of a stem, or secondary stem arising from the main stem of a plant.
bush	A bush is a low woody perennial plant that usually has several major stems.
flower	A flower is a plant cultivated for its blooms or blossoms.
grass	Grass is a green herbage that is grown as lawns and used as pasture for grazing animals.
leaf	A leaf is the main organ of photosynthesis and transpiration in higher plants.
nature	Nature is the natural physical world including plants, animals, and landscapes.
plant	A plant is a living organism lacking the power of locomotion.
seed	A seed is something that is sowed in order to grow a plant.
thorn	A thorn is a small sharp-pointed tip resembling a spike on a stem or leaf.
sprout	A sprout is a newly grown bud.
tree	A tree is a tall perennial woody plant having a main trunk and branches forming a distinct elevated crown.
weed	A weed is a plant that crowds out cultivated plants.
