

## Spelling list: Times of the day

Learn to spell times of the day.

afternoon	<b>Afternoon</b> is the part of the day between noon and evening.
daytime	<b>Daytime</b> is the time after sunrise and before sunset while it is light outside.
dusk	<b>Dusk</b> is the time of day immediately following sunset.
evening	<b>Evening</b> is the period of decreasing daylight from late afternoon until nightfall.
midnight	<b>Midnight</b> refers to twelve o'clock at night.
morning	<b>Morning</b> is the time period between dawn and noon.
night	<b>Night</b> is the time after sunset and before sunrise while it is dark outside.
nighttime	<b>Nighttime</b> is the time after sunset and before sunrise while it is dark outside.
noon	<b>Noon</b> refers to twelve o'clock in the middle of the day.
sunrise	<b>Sunrise</b> is the daily event of the sun rising above the horizon.
sunset	<b>Sunset</b> is the daily event of the sun sinking below the horizon.
