

Spelling list: Weather types

Learn to spell these types of weather.

cloud	A cloud is a visible mass of water or ice particles suspended at a considerable altitude.
fog	Fog describes an atmosphere where visibility is reduced.
hail	Hail is when rain freezes into ice pellets that fall from the air.
monsoon	A monsoon is a seasonal wind that brings rain from the southwest in the summer.
rain	Rain is when water drops fall from the sky.
rainbow	A rainbow is an arc of coloured light in the sky caused by refraction of the sun's rays by rain.
snow	Snow is precipitation falling from clouds in the form of ice crystals.
storm	A storm is a violent combination of heavy wind, rain, and thunder and lightening.
sunshine	Sunshine describes the warmth and light from the rays of the sun.
forecast	A forecast is a prediction of what the weather will be like.
typhoon	A typhoon is a tropical cyclone occurring in the western Pacific or Indian oceans.
wind	Wind is air that moves with considerable force.
