

## Spelling list: Weather types

Learn to spell these types of weather.

cloud	A <b>cloud</b> is a visible mass of water or ice particles suspended at a considerable altitude.
fog	<b>Fog</b> describes an atmosphere where visibility is reduced.
hail	<b>Hail</b> is when rain freezes into ice pellets that fall from the air.
monsoon	A <b>monsoon</b> is a seasonal wind that brings rain from the southwest in the summer.
rain	<b>Rain</b> is when water drops fall from the sky.
rainbow	A <b>rainbow</b> is an arc of coloured light in the sky caused by refraction of the sun's rays by rain.
snow	<b>Snow</b> is precipitation falling from clouds in the form of ice crystals.
storm	A <b>storm</b> is a violent combination of heavy wind, rain, and thunder and lightening.
sunshine	<b>Sunshine</b> describes the warmth and light from the rays of the sun.
forecast	A <b>forecast</b> is a prediction of what the weather will be like.
typhoon	A <b>typhoon</b> is a tropical cyclone occurring in the western Pacific or Indian oceans.
wind	<b>Wind</b> is air that moves with considerable force.
