scales	I used <b>scales</b> to measure my ingredients.
pan	A <b>pan</b> is a wide metal vessel used for cooking food in.

sugar	I love pancakes with lemon and <b>sugar</b> .

Wednesday	Ash <b>Wednesday</b> is the first day of Lent.
