

## Spelling list: ably ibly

Use -ably if there is a root word with the suffix removed. Use -ibly if there isn't a word when the suffix is taken away.

possibly	Pigs cannot <b>possibly</b> fly!
adorably	The dog was <b>adorably</b> soft.
horribly	The skier landed <b>horribly</b> and broke her ankle.
enjoyably	The day passed <b>enjoyably</b> and we all had fun.
agreeably	The fruit has an <b>agreeably</b> acidic flavour.
incredibly	My friend plays the cello <b>incredibly</b> well.
sensibly	You must learn to behave <b>sensibly</b> .
respectably	The prime minister was <b>respectably</b> dressed.
legibly	You need to ensure that you write <b>legibly</b> .
reliably	I am <b>reliably</b> informed that you haven't done your homework.
terribly	We got <b>terribly</b> wet in the storm.
forgivably	The puppy was <b>forgivably</b> naughty.
