Use -ably if there is a root word with the suffix removed. Use -ibly if there isn't a word when the suffix is taken away.

| sensibly | You must learn to behave sensibly . |
| respectably | The prime minister was respectably dressed. |
| legibly | You need to ensure that you write legibly . |
| reliably | I am reliably informed that you haven't done your homework. |
| terribly | We got terribly wet in the storm. |
| forgivably | The puppy was forgivably naughty. |
