

## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (capable - code)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

capable	If you <b>capable</b> of doing something, it means you have the skills to do it.
capacity	The <b>capacity</b> of something is the the amount that can be contained within it.
categories	<b>Categories</b> are collections of things that are grouped by common attributes.
ceases	If something <b>ceases</b> , it means it ends.
challenge	A <b>challenge</b> is a demanding or stimulating situation.
channel	A <b>channel</b> is a path over which electrical signals can pass or a passage for water (or other fluids) to flow through.
chapter	A <b>chapter</b> is a subdivision of a written work.
character	A <b>character</b> is an imaginary person represented in a work of fiction.
chart	A <b>chart</b> is a visual display of information.
chemical	A <b>chemical</b> is a material produced by or used in a reaction.
circumstance	A <b>circumstance</b> is a condition that influences an event or activity.
cite	If you <b>cite</b> something, it means you make reference to its source.
civil	If something is <b>civil</b> it is of or occurring within the state or between or among citizens of the state.
clarity	<b>Clarity</b> refers to how easy something is to understand.
classical	<b>Classical</b> means relating to Ancient Greek or Latin art and culture.
clause	A <b>clause</b> is a group of words containing a verb.
code	A <b>code</b> is a set of rules, principles, or laws.
