## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (capable - code)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

capable	If you <b>capable</b> of doing something, it means you have the skills to do it.
capacity	The <b>capacity</b> of something is the the amount that can be contained within it.
categories	Categories are collections of things that are grouped by common attributes.
ceases	If something <b>ceases</b> , it means it ends.
challenge	A challenge is a demanding or stimulating situation.
channel	A <b>channel</b> is a path over which electrical signals can pass or a passage for water (or other fluids) to flow through.
chapter	A chapter is a subdivision of a written work.
character	A character is an imaginary person represented in a work of fiction.
chart	A chart is a visual display of information.
chemical	A chemical is a material produced by or used in a reaction.
circumstance	A circumstance is a condition that influences an event or activity.
cite	If you <b>cite</b> something, it means you make reference to its source.
civil	If something is <b>civil</b> it is of or occurring within the state or between or among citizens of the state.
clarity	Clarity refers to how easy something is to understand.
classical	Classical means relating to Ancient Greek or Latin art and culture.
clause	A clause is a group of words containing a verb.
code	A code is a set of rules, principles, or laws.
