

Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (coherence - compensation)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

coherence	Coherence is the quality of being logical, orderly, and consistent.
coincide	If two things coincide , it means they happen at the same time.
collapse	If you collapse , it means you fall down or fall apart.
colleagues	Colleagues are the people you work with.
combine	If you combine two things, it means you mix them together.
commenced	If something has commenced , it means it has started.
comment	A comment is a statement that expresses a personal opinion.
commission	If you commission something, it means you place an order for it.
commit	If you commit to something, it means you agree to do it.
commitment	Commitment is the act of being dedicated to a cause, activity, or person.
commodity	A commodity is something that can be bought or sold.
communicate	If you communicate with someone, it means you share information or your thoughts with them.
communication	Communication is the activity of sharing information with other people.
community	A community is a group of people living in a particular local area.
companion	A companion is a friend who often keeps you company.
compassion	Compassion is a deep awareness of and sympathy for another's suffering.
compensation	Compensation is something (such as money) given or received as payment in recognition of loss or injury.
