

## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (coherence - compensation)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

coherence	<b>Coherence</b> is the quality of being logical, orderly, and consistent.
coincide	If two things <b>coincide</b> , it means they happen at the same time.
collapse	If you <b>collapse</b> , it means you fall down or fall apart.
colleagues	<b>Colleagues</b> are the people you work with.
combine	If you <b>combine</b> two things, it means you mix them together.
commenced	If something has <b>commenced</b> , it means it has started.
comment	A <b>comment</b> is a statement that expresses a personal opinion.
commission	If you <b>commission</b> something, it means you place an order for it.
commit	If you <b>commit</b> to something, it means you agree to do it.
commitment	<b>Commitment</b> is the act of being dedicated to a cause, activity, or person.
commodity	A <b>commodity</b> is something that can be bought or sold.
communicate	If you <b>communicate</b> with someone, it means you share information or your thoughts with them.
communication	<b>Communication</b> is the activity of sharing information with other people.
community	A <b>community</b> is a group of people living in a particular local area.
companion	A <b>companion</b> is a friend who often keeps you company.
compassion	<b>Compassion</b> is a deep awareness of and sympathy for another's suffering.
compensation	<b>Compensation</b> is something (such as money) given or received as payment in recognition of loss or injury.
