Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (coherence - compensation)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

coherence is the quality of being logical, orderly, and consistent.

collapse If you **collapse**, it means you fall down or fall apart.
