Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (confer - constraints)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

confer	If you confer with someone, it means you discuss something with them.

consistent	If something is consistent , it means it behaves in the same way over time.
constant	If something is constant , it means it is unvarying in nature.
constitute	Constitute means made up of or composed from.

If something is constitutional, it means it is operating under the political

principles of a government.
