

## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (convinced - cycle)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

convinced	If you are <b>convinced</b> of something, it means you are sure of it.
cooperate	If you <b>cooperate</b> with someone, it means you work together with them.
cooperative	If you <b>cooperative</b> , it means you help with something even if you don't necessarily want to.
coordinate	A <b>coordinate</b> is a number that identifies a position relative to an axis.
coordination	<b>Coordination</b> is the skilled and effective interaction of movements.
core	A <b>core</b> is the centre of an object.
correspond	If you <b>correspond</b> with someone, it means you keep in touch with them.
couple	<b>Couple</b> means two.
courteous	If you are <b>courteous</b> , it means you have good manners.
crave	If you <b>crave</b> something, it means you have a great desire for it.
create	If you <b>create</b> something, it means you make it.
credit	If you buy something on <b>credit</b> , it means you will pay for it at a later date.
criteria	<b>Criteria</b> are the reference points against which other things can be evaluated.
crucial	If something is <b>crucial</b> , it means it is extremely important.
cultural	<b>Cultural</b> means relating to the arts and customs of a particular group.
currency	<b>Currency</b> is a system of money.
cycle	A <b>cycle</b> is an interval during which a recurring sequence of events occurs.
