| simulation | A simulation is an imitation of a situation. |
| site | A site is a piece of land on which something is located. |
| slither | If you slither , it means you move like a snake. |
| sluggish | If something is sluggish , it means it is slow or inactive. |
| soar | If you soar , it means you rise high in the air and fly. |
| so-called | So-called is used to describe something that is doubtful or suspect. |
| solar | If something is solar , it means it is related to the sun. |
| solely | If you do something solely , it means you do it without any others being included or involved. |
| solitary | If something is solitary , it means it exists on its own. |
| solo | A solo activity is one that is performed alone without assistance. |
| somewhat | Somewhat means to a small degree or extent. |
| soothe | If you soothe someone, you gently support them. |
| sought | If something is being sought , it means it is being searched for. |
| source | The source of something is the place where it begins or comes from. |
| sparse | If something is sparse , it means it is in short supply. |
| specific | If something is specific , it means it is precise and clearly defined. |
| specify | If you specify something, it means you define it clearly. |
| sphere | A sphere is a round 3D shape like a ball. |
