

Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (sum - synonym)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

| sum | A sum of something is its total amount. |
| summary | A summary is a brief statement that presents the main points of something. |
| summit | A summit is the top of a hill or mountain. |
| superior | If something is superior , it means it is better. |
| supplement | A supplement is something that is added to something else in order to make it better or complete. |
| supplementary | Supplementary is another word for additional or extra. |
| survey | A survey is a detailed critical inspection. |
| survive | If you survive , it means you continue to exist despite hardship. |
| suspend | If you suspend someone, it means you temporarily ban them from taking part in something. |
| sustain | If you sustain something, you strengthen and support it. |
| sustainable | If something is sustainable , it means it is possible to maintain and support it. |
| swarm | A swarm is a large, dense, moving group of insects. |
| symbol | A symbol is a visible thing that represents something else. |
| symbolic | If something is symbolic , it means it is related to a symbol. |
| synonym | A synonym is a word that means the same as another word. A synonym for 'big' is 'large'. |
