

Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (negate - numerous)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

negate	If you negate something, it means you make it ineffective.
negative	If something is negative , it means it is characterised by denial, opposition, or resistance.
network	A network is an interconnected system of things or people.
neutral	If someone is neutral , it means they do not favour either side of a dispute.
nevertheless	Nevertheless means 'despite anything to the contrary'.
nonchalant	If someone is nonchalant , it means they are unconcerned.
nonetheless	Nonetheless means 'despite anything to the contrary'.
normal	If something is normal , it means it confirms to a collective standard.
norms	The norms are the things that are typical for a particular time, group, or situation.
notion	A notion is a vague idea in which some confidence is placed.
notwithstanding	Notwithstanding means 'despite anything to the contrary'.
nuclear	If something is nuclear , it means it relates to the nucleus of an atom.
numerous	Numerous is another word for many.
