

## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (job - logic)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

job	A <b>job</b> is what you do to earn money.
journal	A <b>journal</b> is a written record of your experiences and observations.
justification	A <b>justification</b> is something (such as a fact or circumstance) that shows an action to be reasonable or necessary.
justify	If you <b>justify</b> something, it means you show it to be reasonable.
label	A <b>label</b> is a small piece of paper (or similar material) attached to an item to provide information about it.
labour	<b>Labour</b> means work.
layer	A <b>layer</b> is a sheet or coating that covers something.
lecture	A <b>lecture</b> is a talk given by an expert on a particular subject.
legal	If something is <b>legal</b> , it means it is related to law.
legislate	To <b>legislate</b> means to make laws.
legislation	<b>Legislation</b> is the act of making laws.
levy	A <b>levy</b> is a charge that is collected, like a tax.
liberal	If you are <b>liberal</b> , it means you have political or social views favouring reform and progress.
licence	A <b>licence</b> is a legal document giving official permission to do something.
likewise	<b>Likewise</b> means 'in addition to'.
link	If you <b>link</b> two things, it means you join or connect them.
location	A <b>location</b> is a particular place .
