

## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (facilitate - fluctuations)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

facilitate	If you <b>facilitate</b> something, you make it easier for it to happen.
factor	A <b>factor</b> is anything that contributes to a result.
feature	A <b>feature</b> is a prominent attribute or aspect of something.
federal	If something is <b>federal</b> , it means it is related to the central government of a federation.
fees	<b>Fees</b> are charges you pay in exchange for a professional service.
file	A <b>file</b> is a set of related records.
final	If something is <b>final</b> it is not to be altered or undone.
finance	<b>Finance</b> is the commercial activity of providing funds and capital.
financial	If something is <b>financial</b> , it means it is related to the commercial activity of providing funds and capital.
finite	If something is <b>finite</b> , it means there is only a certain amount of it.
flexibility	<b>Flexibility</b> is how easily something can be bent or shaped.
fluctuations	<b>Fluctuations</b> are instances of change to a number or amount.
