

Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (target - thereby)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

target	A target is a reference point to shoot at.
task	A task is a piece of work which must be completed.
taunt	If you taunt someone, it means you mock or tease them.
team	A team is made up of two or more people working together.
technical	If something is technical , it means it is related to a particular subject or field.
technique	A technique is a practical method used to perform a task.
technology	Technology is the practical application of science to commerce or industry.
temporary	If something is temporary , it means it is not permanent.
tension	Tension is the physical condition of being stretched or strained.
termination	Termination is the act of ending something.
text	Text refers to the words of something written.
theme	A theme is a unifying idea that is a recurrent element in literary or artistic work.
theory	A theory is a concept that is not yet verified but that if true would explain certain facts.
thereby	Thereby is used to describe the means by which something happened.
