

## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (thesis- trigger)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

thesis	A <b>thesis</b> is an unproved statement put forward as a premise in an argument.
topic	A <b>topic</b> is the subject matter of a conversation or discussion.
trace	If you <b>trace</b> something, it means you follow it back to its origins.
tradition	A <b>tradition</b> is a custom or practice that is passed down from one generation to the next.
traditional	If something is <b>traditional</b> , it means it is part of or comes from a tradition.
transfer	If you <b>transfer</b> something, it means you move it from one place to another.
transformation	<b>Transformation</b> is the act of changing in form, shape, or appearance.
transit	<b>Transit</b> is the movement of passengers or goods to another place.
transition	A <b>transition</b> is the act of passing from one state or place to the next.
transmission	A <b>transmission</b> is a message sent by transmitted signals.
transport	<b>Transport</b> is the commercial enterprise of moving people, goods, and materials.
trend	A <b>trend</b> is a popular taste at a given time.
trigger	A <b>trigger</b> is a device or an act that sets in motion some course of events.
