

Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (via - withdraw)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

via	If you go via somewhere, it means you travel through it on your way to your final destination.
violation	A violation is an act that disregards an agreement or a right.
virtually	Virtually means in essence or effect but not in fact.
visible	If something is visible , it means you can see it.
vision	Vision is the ability to see.
visual	Visual means related to sight.
vivid	If something is vivid , it means it is striking and powerful.
volume	Volume is the amount of 3D space occupied by an object.
voluntary	If something is voluntary , it means you have a choice about whether or not you do it.
welfare	Welfare is a state of being happy, healthy, and prosperous.
whereas	The word whereas is used to introduce a contrasting idea.
whereby	Whereby is used to describe the way by which someone does something.
widespread	Widespread means present over a large area.
withdraw	If you withdraw from something, it means you step back from it.
