

Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (distinction - dynamic)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

distinction	A distinction is something that makes two things different.
distorted	If something is distorted , it means it is blurred or pulled out of shape.
distribute	If you distribute something, it means you give it out to people.
distribution	Distribution is the act of giving things out to people.
diverse	Diverse means many and different.
diversity	Diversity is the practice of including people from many different backgrounds.
document	A document is a written account that provides information.
domain	A domain is territory over which rule or control is exercised.
domestic	Domestic means relating to the home.
dominant	If something is dominant , it means it exercises influence or control.
dominate	If you dominate , it means you have power, influence, or control.
draft	A draft is a preliminary version of a design or piece of writing.
dramatic	If something is dramatic , it means it is sensational in appearance or thrilling in effect.
duration	Duration is the period of time during which something continues.
dynamic	If something is dynamic , it means it is characterised by action or forcefulness or force of personality.
