

## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (relevant - restore)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

relevant	If something is <b>relevant</b> to a subject, it means it is connected to or has bearing to it.
reliance	<b>Reliance</b> is the state of depending on something.
reluctant	If you are <b>reluctant</b> to do something, it means you are unwilling or disinclined to do it.
remote	If somewhere is <b>remote</b> , it means it is far away.
removed	If something is <b>removed</b> , it means it is taken away.
require	If you <b>require</b> something, it means you need it.
research	If you <b>research</b> something, it means you investigate it in a systematic and scientific way.
resemble	If two things <b>resemble</b> each other, it means they look alike.
reside	If you <b>reside</b> somewhere, it means you live there.
resident	A <b>resident</b> is someone who lives in a particular place.
resolution	A <b>resolution</b> is a decision to do something or to behave in a certain manner.
resolve	If you <b>resolve</b> to do something, it means you decide to do it.
resource	A <b>resource</b> is a source of aid or support that may be drawn upon when needed.
respond	If you <b>respond</b> to something, it means you react to it verbally.
response	A <b>response</b> is a statement that is made in reply to a question, request, or criticism.
	If you <b>restore</b> something, it means you return it to a usable and functioning
