Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (relevant - restore)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

If something is **relevant** to a subject, it means it is connected to or has relevant

bearing to it.

reliance Reliance is the state of depending on something.
