

Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (relevant - restore)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

relevant	If something is relevant to a subject, it means it is connected to or has bearing to it.
reliance	Reliance is the state of depending on something.
reluctant	If you are reluctant to do something, it means you are unwilling or disinclined to do it.
remote	If somewhere is remote , it means it is far away.
removed	If something is removed , it means it is taken away.
require	If you require something, it means you need it.
research	If you research something, it means you investigate it in a systematic and scientific way.
resemble	If two things resemble each other, it means they look alike.
reside	If you reside somewhere, it means you live there.
resident	A resident is someone who lives in a particular place.
resolution	A resolution is a decision to do something or to behave in a certain manner.
resolve	If you resolve to do something, it means you decide to do it.
resource	A resource is a source of aid or support that may be drawn upon when needed.
respond	If you respond to something, it means you react to it verbally.
response	A response is a statement that is made in reply to a question, request, or criticism. If you restore something, it means you return it to a usable and functioning
