

Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (restraints - route)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

restraints	Restraints are rules or conditions that limit freedom.
restrict	If you restrict something, it means you place limits on it.
retain	If you retain something, it means you keep hold of it.
retire	If you retire , it means you withdraw from your work and duties.
retrieve	If you retrieve something, it means you fetch it.
reveal	If you reveal something, it means you make it visible or known.
revenue	Your revenue is the entire amount of income before any deductions are made.
reverse	To reverse means to go backwards.
revert	If you revert to something, it means you return to its previous state.
revision	Revision is the process of going over something.
revolution	Revolution is the overthrow of a government by those who are governed.
rigid	If something is rigid , it means it is resistant to bending.
rigorous	If a process is rigorous , it means it is thorough, careful, and accurate.
role	The word role describes the actions and activities assigned to or expected of a person or group.
route	A route is an established line of travel or access.
