

## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (restraints - route)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

restraints	<b>Restraints</b> are rules or conditions that limit freedom.
restrict	If you <b>restrict</b> something, it means you place limits on it.
retain	If you <b>retain</b> something, it means you keep hold of it.
retire	If you <b>retire</b> , it means you withdraw from your work and duties.
retrieve	If you <b>retrieve</b> something, it means you fetch it.
reveal	If you <b>reveal</b> something, it means you make it visible or known.
revenue	Your <b>revenue</b> is the entire amount of income before any deductions are made.
reverse	To <b>reverse</b> means to go backwards.
revert	If you <b>revert</b> to something, it means you return to its previous state.
revision	<b>Revision</b> is the process of going over something.
revolution	<b>Revolution</b> is the overthrow of a government by those who are governed.
rigid	If something is <b>rigid</b> , it means it is resistant to bending.
rigorous	If a process is <b>rigorous</b> , it means it is thorough, careful, and accurate.
role	The word <b>role</b> describes the actions and activities assigned to or expected of a person or group.
route	A <b>route</b> is an established line of travel or access.
