

## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (exceed - extract)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

exceed	<b>Exceed</b> means to be greater in scope or size than a set standard.
exclude	If you <b>exclude</b> someone, it means you leave them out.
exert	If you <b>exert</b> yourself, it means you make a physical or mental effort.
exhibit	If you <b>exhibit</b> something, it means you show or display it.
expand	<b>Expand</b> means to extend in one or more directions.
expansion	<b>Expansion</b> is the act of increasing.
expert	An <b>expert</b> is a person with special knowledge or ability in a particular field.
explicit	If something is <b>explicit</b> , it means it is precisely and clearly expressed.
exploitation	<b>Exploitation</b> is the act of treating someone unfairly in order to profit from them.
export	If you <b>export</b> something, it means you sell or transfer it abroad.
expose	If you <b>expose</b> something, it means you make it visible or known.
exposure	<b>Exposure</b> is the state of being exposed.
external	<b>External</b> means happening, arising, or located outside.
extract	An <b>extract</b> is a passage selected from a larger work.
