

Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (panel - period)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

panel	A panel is a group of people gathered for a special purpose, such as discussing an issue or judging a contest.
paradigm	A paradigm is a standard or typical example.
paragraph	A paragraph is a subdivision in a text.
parallel	If two lines are parallel , it means they are equidistant and not intersecting.
parameters	Parameters are factors that define a system and determine its performance.
pardon	If you pardon something, it means you excuse it.
participate	If you participate in something, it means you get involved with it.
participation	Participation is the act of sharing in the activities of a group.
partner	A partner is someone you work on a particular activity with.
partnership	A partnership is a cooperative relationship between people or groups who agree to share responsibility for achieving a specific goal.
passive	If something is passive , it means they accept or allow things to happen without expressing resistance.
pasture	A pasture is a field.
pedestrian	A pedestrian is a person who travels by foot.
perceived	If something is perceived , it means it is detected by means of the senses.
percent	A percent is a proportion of a hundred.
period	A period is an amount of time.
