

## Spelling list: Tier 2 Words (panel - period)

Tier 2 words are less common than high frequency (Tier 1) words. They are often integral to the comprehension of exam questions or core subject knowledge.

| panel         | A <b>panel</b> is a group of people gathered for a special purpose, such as discussing an issue or judging a contest.                        |
| paradigm      | A <b>paradigm</b> is a standard or typical example.  |
| paragraph     | A <b>paragraph</b> is a subdivision in a text.   |
| parallel      | If two lines are <b>parallel</b> , it means they are equidistant and not intersecting.   |
| parameters    | <b>Parameters</b> are factors that define a system and determine its performance.  |
| pardon        | If you <b>pardon</b> something, it means you excuse it.  |
| participate   | If you <b>participate</b> in something, it means you get involved with it.   |
| participation | <b>Participation</b> is the act of sharing in the activities of a group.   |
| partner       | A <b>partner</b> is someone you work on a particular activity with.  |
| partnership   | A <b>partnership</b> is a cooperative relationship between people or groups who agree to share responsibility for achieving a specific goal. |
| passive       | If something is <b>passive</b> , it means they accept or allow things to happen without expressing resistance.                               |
| pasture       | A <b>pasture</b> is a field.   |
| pedestrian    | A <b>pedestrian</b> is a person who travels by foot.   |
| perceived     | If something is <b>perceived</b> , it means it is detected by means of the senses.   |
| percent       | A <b>percent</b> is a proportion of a hundred.   |
| period        | A <b>period</b> is an amount of time.  |
